Gear/equipment we use:

<u>Ipad/Tablet</u> - the newer the better (improved mics/sound quality, low-light capability and image stabilization), but we used our 2015 ipad from 2015 to 2021 without issue.

<u>Case Ipad/Tablet</u> - we use "Megamount Professional Media Rig" case. Look for a "videographer" or "filmmaker" case for your ipad/tablet, it will have a "cold shoe" mount for your light and will attach to a standard tripod or monopod.

If you don't plan to mount a light, you can also put your tablet in an Otterbox, or other protective case and use a clamp-type mount. The best one paired with an Ipad Otterbox is the "Neewer Tablet Tripod Mount Adapter Tablet Clamp Holder." It has a screw-tightened clamp which doesn't loosen, doesn't wobble and is easy to take on and off.

<u>Monopod/Tripod</u> - Highly recommend a monopod with "feet" for easy mobility. Our 'high-end' one is the iFootage Cobra 2 C180-II (it seems to be more expensive now than when we bought ours). The "Moman Unipod Monopod Tripod" is one of the better (more stable) cheaper ones I found.

<u>Light</u> - most on-camera LED lights will be fine. Ours is the Apurture MC which we purchased when we had a decent budget. Look for a dimmable or adjustable "on-camera" or "mini" LED light. Neewer or Ulanzi products are surprisingly good knockoffs of the brand name gear. Some lights come with a mount if not, you'll need this to attach it to your ipad case.
