This tour will highlight renovations and new builds within the Waterloo-Wellington Museums and Art Galleries Network, including:

#### 1. Region of Waterloo Archives

The first stand-alone archives to receive a Museum Assistance Program (MAP) grant in 2010, the Region of Waterloo Archives has a new descriptive database and a newly renovated storage vault and reading room / gallery.

#### 2. Joseph Schneider Haus Museum & Galleries

Joseph Schneider Haus Museum & Galleries – Visit the restored to 1856 Pennsylvania Mennonite farmhouse in the heart of downtown Kitchener and tour the newly reproduced Wash House, part of the historic environs including a Springhouse and Bake House.

#### 3. Scenic Drive to the Wellington County Museum and Archives

#### 4. Wellington County Museum and Archives

In June 2010, the Wellington County Museum and Archives, a National Historic Site, opened an 8,000 square foot archives addition complete with state-of-the-art storage vault, processing room, reading room, accessible washroom and office space. In addition, previous archival space has been transformed into a large conservation lab and work room.

#### 5. Guelph Museums

A behind the scenes tour of the restoration of the Loreto Convent, which opens in the late fall of 2011 as the new home of the Guelph Civic Museum.

#### 6. Cambridge Centre for the Arts

Innovative and inviting, located in downtown Cambridge this site adds to the growing sense of action and vitality in this growing urban centre.

#### 7. McDougall Cottage

Region of Waterloo's "wee" cottage on the banks of the Grand River is a small but mighty example of renovation at its best.
