

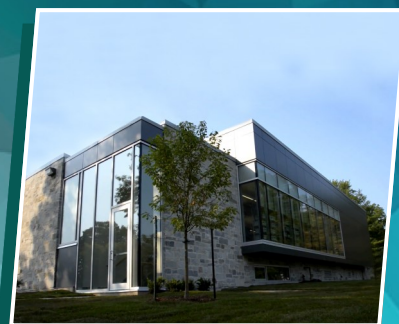
# CAPITAL RENEWAL STUDY TOUR
